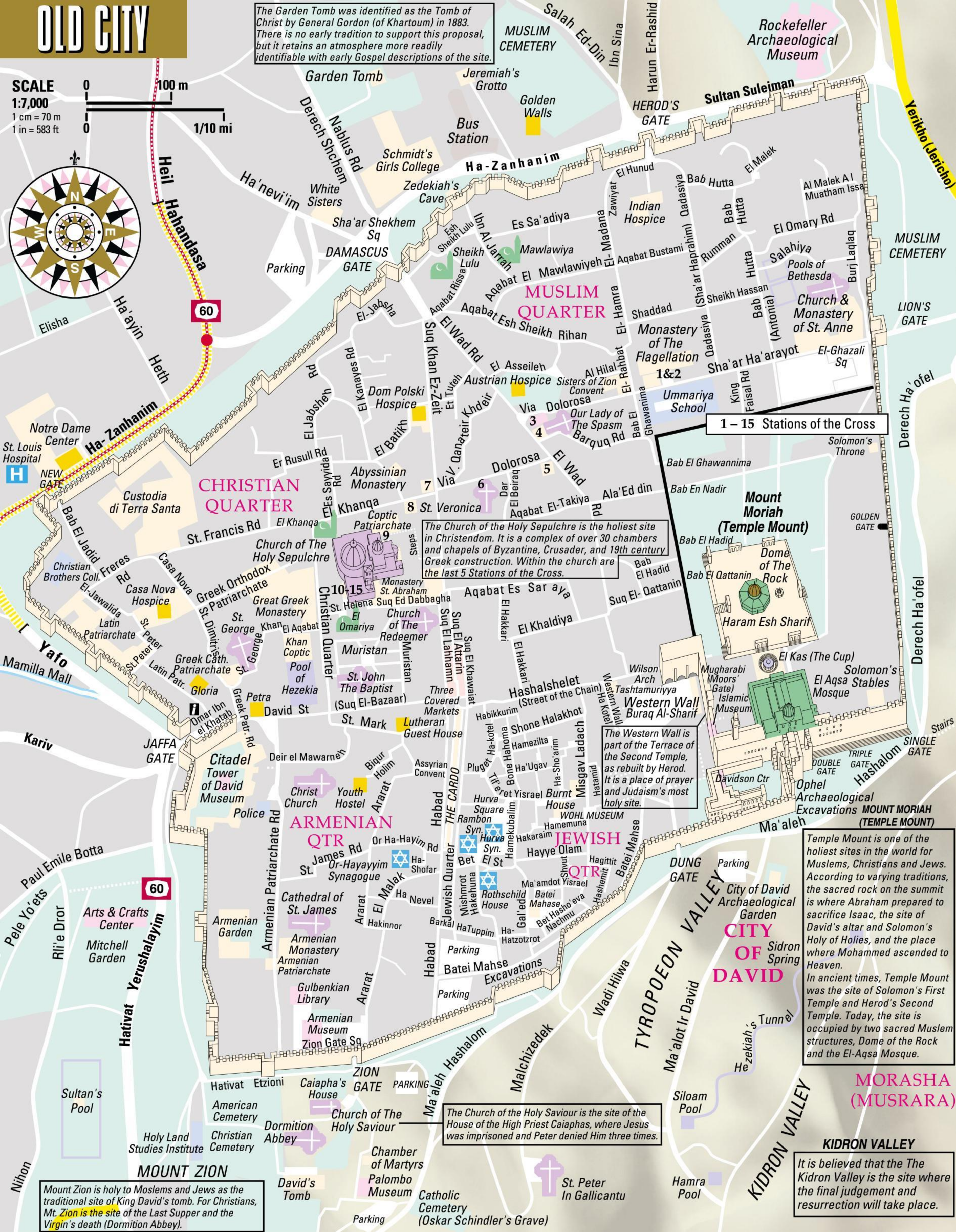
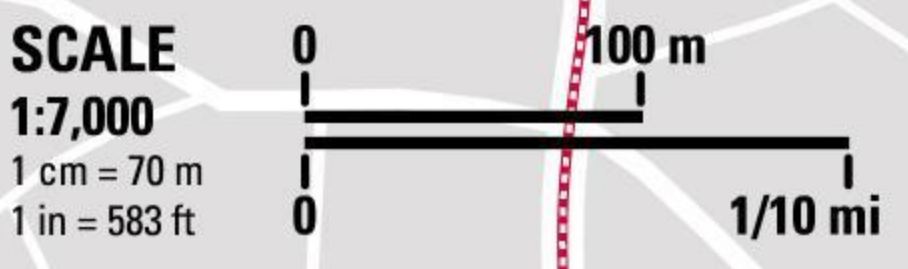


OLD CITY

The Garden Tomb was identified as the Tomb of Christ by General Gordon (of Khartoum) in 1883. There is no early tradition to support this proposal, but it retains an atmosphere more readily identifiable with early Gospel descriptions of the site.



The Church of the Holy Sepulchre is the holiest site in Christendom. It is a complex of over 30 chambers and chapels of Byzantine, Crusader, and 19th century Greek construction. Within the church are the last 5 Stations of the Cross.

The Western Wall is part of the Terrace of the Second Temple, as rebuilt by Herod. It is a place of prayer and Judaism's most holy site.

Temple Mount is one of the holiest sites in the world for Muslims, Christians and Jews. According to varying traditions, the sacred rock on the summit is where Abraham prepared to sacrifice Isaac, the site of David's altar and Solomon's Holy of Holies, and the place where Mohammed ascended to Heaven.
